1. What Are Cookies

Cookies are small text files that are downloaded to your computer or other device when you access a website. Cookies recognise your device and store some information about your preferences or past actions.

This policy describes what information these cookies gather, how we use it and why we sometimes need to store these cookies. Information on how to disable and delete cookies is below, although disabling cookies may affect this website's functionality.

2. How We Use Cookies

We use cookies for the reasons set out below:

- 1) To recognise your device when you visit our website.

We use cookies to remember that you have visited our site previously so that we can improve your user experience.

- 2) To help us to understand how you use the site.

This site uses Squarespace's trusted analytics solution to help us to understand how you use the site and ways that we can improve your experience.

When you use this website, you may therefore be sent third party cookies.

These cookies may track things such as how long you spend on the site and the pages that you visit so we can continue to produce engaging content and improve your user experience.

- 3) Testing in order to improve the site's usability.

From time to time we test new features and make subtle changes to the way that the site is delivered. While we test new features, we may use cookies to ensure that you receive a consistent experience whilst on the site whilst ensuring we understand which optimisations our users appreciate the most.

3. Disabling and Deleting Cookies

You can prevent the setting of cookies and delete cookies already stored on your computer by adjusting the settings on your browser. See your web browser's 'Help' section for instructions on how to do this.

Please note that disabling cookies may affect the functionality and features of this website, meaning that you may not be able to use the website as you may wish to.

4. Personal identification information

If you choose to input your name and email address into our website in order to contact us, we will collect this information and use it for the purpose of dealing with and responding to your enquiry.

Our web server will not hold any information regarding your domain or email address or other personal identification information, except that your device's IP address may be ascertainable by our analytics provider.

5. Variations to the policy

From time to time, we may use customer information for new, unanticipated uses that have not been previously disclosed in our privacy notice. If our information practices change at some time in the future we will post the policy changes to our website to notify you of these changes.
